

# Redevelopment Update December 2009



With the construction crane now in place, Phase 2 of the new Our Lady of Mercy Patient Care Wing is off to a healthy start. First floor columns are nearing completion and construction of the second floor concrete slab is well underway. We now have a number of construction trades represented on site including ironworkers (reinforcing steel), concrete forming, electrical, mechanical (plumbers) and sheet-metal with a total force of more than 60 workers strong and growing.

Now that construction is above grade, construction activity is more noticeable from the streets surrounding the Health Centre. And with the increased frequency of concrete pours, comes increased activity on nights and early mornings when concrete finishing work must be completed. The Contractor will be using construction work lights to complete this work but they have committed to the Health Centre that they will minimize both light and noise disruption to the neighbouring community, as much as possible.

With the winter season upon us, we don't expect to completely escape the effects of the winter weather, but are optimistic that construction can continue with minimum disruption.
