

# Redevelopment Update June 2010



With the concrete structure of the new OLM Building now complete, the construction crane was recently removed from the site. The Contractor's focus has shifted to closing in the exterior building envelope and continuing with the interior rough in work.

The installation of exterior brick and limestone has commenced on levels 1 and 2 of the building's west elevation. Window frames have been installed and glass is complete on levels 1 and 2 and is continuing on level 3. The structural steel for the main entry was recently installed and the curtain wall system will follow at a later date.

Rooftop mechanical units have arrived for the level 2 roof area and additional mechanical units will be arriving shortly for the Penthouse and level 4 roof area. Roofing is also nearing completion. Inside the building, interior wall framing is complete on levels 1 and 2 and is continuing on level 3. Installation of the passenger elevator rails has commenced. Electrical and mechanical rough-in work is continuing on all levels of the building.

With the warmer weather upon us, the Health

Centre has reminded the Contractor that noisy work before 8:00 a.m. is not permitted. When early morning work is necessary to our building and contractor's schedule - and if that early morning work may be noisy - the Health Centre endeavours to give residents advance notice as early as reasonably possible.
