

Redevelopment Update - June 2011



As we head into the summer months, work on the Our Lady of Mercy (OLM) wing is forging ahead. On the exterior of the building caulking is now complete and exterior landscaping work is ramping up. The primary focus continues to be interior finishing work, electrical, and mechanical systems as we move forward towards completion.

The ground level of the parking garage is receiving some finishing touches, including the completion of insulation, drywall, taping and trim. The main elevators have been installed and the service elevators are nearing completion. The first floor of the building, which will house the Family Birthing Centre and Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, has flooring in the rooms complete with the corridors to follow. Painting continues throughout. Ongoing work on the second floor, which will be home to one medical and one surgical inpatient units, includes electrical, mechanical and painting. Ductwork insulation and electrical distribution panel installation has been completed. The Paediatric and Child and Adolescent Mental Health units which will be located on the third floor

of the building have electrical and mechanical work and drywall taping ongoing. Medical gas lines are being installed on the fourth floor, along with insulation of piping and ductwork and drywall taping.

Those departments that are relocating into the OLM wing continue to meet and plan for the move, which is scheduled to take place in late fall.
