

Redevelopment Update May 2011



All the April showers have not dampened the progress on our Our Lady of Mercy (OLM) Patient Care Wing, and despite the grey days, we are looking forward to our new building. The parking garage is nearing completion, as is the first floor, with work on the drywall installation, painting and flooring continuing. The tiling in the showers on the second floor is complete, but there remains work on wiring, mechanical ductwork and painting. The third and fourth floors are progressing well, but still require work in several areas. Drywalling, taping, wiring, and head wall installation are nearly complete on the third floor. And, on the fourth floor, activity is focused on drywall installation and taping, wiring, piping, mechanical ductwork and the installation of medical gas lines. The installation of piping, ductwork and the service elevator is also underway on the penthouse level.

While complete for the most part, the exterior of OLM continues to get some attention, with brick tinting, caulking and cap flashing either complete, or nearly finished. The construction schedule continues to indicate a late summer completion date, after which the clinical programs will begin moving. The programs that are relocating to the new wing continue to plan for their move, and for how they will deliver patient care in their new space.
