

# Redevelopment Update - November 2011



**B**efore the fall comes to an end final landscaping and brick work and paving is taking place on the grounds of the Our Lady of Mercy (OLM) Wing. The pedestrian walkways from Sunnyside Avenue and Parkdale Road have been finished in a decorative interlocking brick; gardens around the entrances have been planted; and sod has been laid on the north east corner of the property.

Inside the building, preparations for the installation of the stained glass windows, taken and restored from the Chapel inside the original Our Lady of Mercy, are underway and that work is expected to be completed by the end of the month. The team stations have been installed on the first and second floors and each of the units are beginning to really take shape.

On the Health Centre side, work has begun on the corridors leading to the OLM Wing and includes new flooring, ceiling, light fixtures and hand rails. The corridor from the back of the Cafeteria will be the main thoroughfare between the Health Centre and

OLM for all patients and visitors once the building is operational.

Meetings with the programs moving and affected support services are on going and beginning to increase in frequency to ensure that everyone is prepared for the relocation of these units. We continue to plan for a handover of the building on January 15, which would lead to a late February – early March move.
