

Redevelopment Update - October 2011



The grounds around the Our Lady of Mercy Wing are shaping up with concrete being poured to form curbs and the pedestrian walk ways to the building from both Sunnyside Avenue and Parkdale Road.

Inside the building the first floor is nearing completion with the final painting taking place and the installation of the care desks at the Team Stations in the new Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and the Family Birthing Centre. Millwork is being installed on the second floor and the sheet flooring in the hallways and painting are almost complete. Work progresses in all areas on the third floor, while the curtain tracks are being installed in the rooms on the fourth floor and painting is ongoing. The stairwells are being finished with lighting fixtures installation underway and painting.

The Health Centre continues to plan for a move in early 2012. The official blessing of the building will take place on December 5th and an open house for our community is being planned for the New Year. Stay up to date by visiting our website at www.stjoe.on.ca.
