

St Joseph's Health Centre Redevelopment Project - Our Lady of Mercy Phase

St. Joseph's Health Centre (SJHC) is a 387-bed community teaching hospital affiliated with the University of Toronto. Founded in 1921, St. Joseph's provides care to a core population of 500,000 residents. Our primary borders run north from Lake Ontario to Eglinton Avenue, east to Ossington Avenue/Bathurst Streets, and west to the Etobicoke Creek. While the majority of our patients come from within these borders, St. Joseph's treats people from across the Greater Toronto Area, the Province of Ontario, Canada and the world.

Our Lady of Mercy Wing

Our planned development of a new 4-storey patient care facility with underground parking garage is underway. Preparatory work has commenced for the demolition of the existing Our Lady of Mercy (OLM) building and construction of the underground parking garage will follow. Construction of the 4-storey patient care facility is anticipated to begin in the summer/fall of 2008. The new facility will feature a new Family Birthing Centre, 60 relocated surgical beds, 28 relocated acute beds, expanded Pediatric services and Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services.

Construction Highlights

Winter 2007:

Preparatory work begins for the demolition of the existing OLM building on January 10th

Spring 2007:

Bulk demolition of OLM building scheduled for completion by early June 2007

Summer and Fall 2007:

Excavation and shoring will continue with completion expected in early October 2007

Winter 2007 / 2008:

Forming and pouring of concrete for the parking structure

Spring and Summer 2008:

Completion of the underground parking garage
