

# Redevelopment Update - August 2011



**A**s we approach the unofficial end of summer, landscaping continues on the grounds of the Our Lady of Mercy Wing. Hoarding has been removed and replaced with chain link fences to make way for landscaping and exterior work.

The construction trailers on the site have now been moved to the north end of the property and preparations for the drive way and surface level parking have begun. The schedule indicates paving to take place late August/early September. Once complete there will be 14 short term surface level parking spots and a pull in drop off area at the front of the wing.

Inside the building the mock up room on the first floor is nearing completion with the arrival of corner guards in early August; flooring inside the rooms has been installed on the second floor and will continue on the floors above; hand washing sinks have been mounted in patients rooms up to the third floor; mounting of millwork and cabinets is on going throughout; fixtures such as television wall mounts

are being installed on the fourth floor; and electrical and mechanical work continues throughout the building.

The Health Centre continues to plan for a move into the new wing in early 2012 and the ordering of furniture will commence shortly. The ribbon cutting for the wing is scheduled to take place on Monday, December 5, 2011 which will also be a celebration of the 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary of St. Joseph's Health Centre. More information about this event will be shared in the coming months.
