

Redevelopment Update - September 2011



As we head into the fall, the final landscaping of the Our Lady of Mercy Wing is approaching completion. The sodding on the west and north sides of the building is complete. Shrubs, small trees and other perennials have also been planted throughout the grounds and in purpose-built planters.

The exterior grounds on the east side of the OLM building along Sunnyside Avenue are also beginning to take shape. The surface parking and drop off area was recently completed with curbs, asphalt, and line painting. The remaining walkways will be completed with concrete paving stones over the next several weeks along with landscape lighting. The interior finishing of the building continues to progress on all floor levels.

Each area that will be relocated into the new wing has formed a Move Team to work through operational readiness and transitional planning activities. One of the Medicine units, 4 East, that will be moving to the fourth floor of OLM was featured in the August 2, 2011 issue of Connections along with a

profile of the Team Leader, Perla Mancao who is coming full circle after beginning her career at OLM in the '70s.
