

# Redevelopment Update April 2010



Construction of the new Our Lady of Mercy patient care wing is progressing well. The dryer than normal weather conditions over the winter months have resulted in limited delays to the schedule. The final major concrete pour topping off the building was successfully completed on March 31. We would like to thank the local residents for their patience over the last three months as the construction crews completed this phase of the build. Please note that future concrete pours over the remainder of construction are small and will not require evening work.

The Contractor is now preparing to commence the installation of the exterior limestone and brick in mid April. Completion of the exterior building envelope and interior rough-in work will be the Contractor's primary focus over the next several months.
