

# Redevelopment Update December 2010



The snow has started to fall and the temperature is dropping as we move closer to the holidays in December. At this point in our construction schedule, the new Our Lady of Mercy Patient Care Wing is mostly closed in and protected from the elements. The glass curtain wall at the front of the building is generally complete with the exception of an access area to allow delivery of large equipment and materials.

Landscaping elements have been installed on the west and north sides of the building with the remainder of the landscaping and planting being completed in the spring.

The majority of the work is now taking place inside the building and in the underground parking garage. On the building's 1st level, drywall is generally complete, the T-bar ceiling installation and some base coat painting have commenced and are ongoing in patient rooms and corridors on this level. A mock up patient room is also underway and being completed for review by the Consultants and Health Centre.

The passenger elevators are nearing completion and installation of the service elevators is well underway.

Drywal and taping on the building's 2nd and

3rd levels are well underway. On the 4th level, stud framing is complete and drywall installation is scheduled to start shortly. Mechanical and electrical rough-in work continues mostly on the upper floors, in the electrical room, and in the penthouse.

The construction schedule still indicates a late spring 2011 completion date and the Health Centre continues to make appropriate plans for occupancy and operational readiness.
